

A New Sight in the Rehearsal Hallway

Through the last few weeks, a very generous volunteer has been working creatively to make a cover for the platforms and frames that "live" in the hall behind the stage. Irene Ellsworth spent weeks measuring, adjusting, cutting, assembling, and sewing the cover that is now in place to protect the equipment. Irene is responsible for several details that make our programs great; she made the panel for the dancers in last year's Vets concert for "Gee I wish I was Back in the Army;" she made the stand-up panels used for pictures at each Jazz Band Dinner Dance, and she made the John Wayne figure used by the band for weekly reminders. Irene admits that of all her projects, the cover for these platforms was

the most challenging and the most frustrating. In the end, though, it looks FANTASTIC! The platforms are a very valuable and expensive part of stage equipment that were purchased four years ago with funds from the school and the Nebo Foundation. The platforms can be adjusted to form "stages" of different heights and widths and are used several times each year. Sometimes when

they are needed most, they have been rendered useless because essential parts have been stolen i.e. pins, extension legs, cables, adjustable metal feet. The cover is expected to prevent such losses in the future, and to make that hall look even better than ever!
